1st Semester Deadline	Nominations: 1 June 2020 – Applications: 15 June 2020
2nd Semester Dedadline	Nominations: 15 November 2020 – Applications: 30 November

Nomination: the partner institutions should nominate their students by e-mail addressed to EASD Mestre Mateo International Office. The nomination will include the name of the student, their e-mail address and the study area.

Online Application: All Students need to fill an online Application downloadable here and submit it and the required documentation by e-mail, addressed to EASD Mestre Mateo International Office.

1. Application form
2. Digital portfolio (link to downloadable pdf, or link to online portfolio will be accepted)
3. Transcript of Records
4. Learning Agreement filled with the chosen or preferred subjects.

Important Information

The students will be allowed to chose among any subject of any of the studies of EASD Mestre Mateo, regardless of their study area.

Please keep in mind that **all the subjects in EASD Mestre Mateo are annual**, except for the 4th year of both Bachelor Degrees, that extend only through the 1st Semester. Therefore, the number of credits of every subject from first to third courses should be divided by 2, for students coming only for either the 1st or the 2nd semester.

Instruction Language: All the subjects are taught in Spanish. Some knowledge of Spanish will be very useful. However, many teachers will be able to communicate in English individually with the incoming students.

The Learning Agreement will be adjusted at the student's arrival, depending on the schedules, the content of the subjects and the previous knowledge the students have about those subjects.

Insurance: Incoming students must have a valid Health Insurance and bring a copy of it with them. The European Health Card is enough for students coming from Europe. It's also acceptable any other private insurance. A liability and accident insurance is also recommended.

Visa: Those students from countries not included in the Schengen area must apply for a study visa to enter in Spain. Applications must be submitted to the Spanish consulates and embassies abroad.
